Ever wondered how you can help your employees optimise their CPF savings? Or better manage and plan their finances?

SNEF is pleased to bring you the Briefing on CPF and MoneySENSE, a collaboration between SNEF, the Central Provident Fund (CPF) and the Monetary Authority of Singapore (MAS). We have invited speakers from both organisations to share with you how companies can better prepare their employees to optimise their CPF savings, plan for retirement and better manage their funds.

Furthermore, as part of its efforts to help older workers remain economically productive, the Government will enact re-employment legislation by 2012 to enable more people to continue working beyond the current statutory retirement age of 62, up to 65 in the first instance and, later, up to 67. This change, accompanied by increased Workfare Income Supplement (WIS) for older, low-wage workers, will complement the CPF Minimum Sum Draw Down Age (DDA), which will progressively be raised from 2012. The Tripartite Implementation Workgroup (TIWG) has identified good practices on re-employment in the Tripartite Advisory on the Re-employment of Older Workers which we have also invited one speaker from the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) to share at this briefing.
