In a personal capacity, Shalini is External Diversity Advisor to Merrill Lynch in Asia Pacific and is a founding board director of The Women's Foundation in Hong Kong. Shalini is also founder of the Suddhananda Vidyalyaya Ammapettai School in Madras, India- a village school for first generation school attendees.

Before Community Business, Shalini had a career in accounting and banking. She is a graduate of the London School of Economics and is a Certified Public Accountant. She is married with two children.
